Re: Invitation to Enter into Go Karting Endurance Fundraiser

Mombasa Round Table No. 3 invites you to a “Go Karting” Endurance race which will take place on **Saturday, 25th October 2008** at the Mombasa Go Karting site near Severin Beach Hotel.

The aim of the event is to raise funds for our various projects such as:-

- **“Weak of Healing”**, whereby we source for Doctors from all over the country to perform free surgery to designated areas within Coast Province.
- **Taru Primary School**, another of our project where we are in the process of constructing additional classrooms, ablution blocks and connect mains water by providing piping system from a distance of about 2 kilometres from the Mombasa Nairobi Highway. We also sponsor bright but needy pupils to secondary schools and up to University level.
- **MSSPH**, (Mombasa Special School for the Physically Handicapped), another of our projects where assist in the running of the school.

The Go Karting Endurance is a car racing event whereby a minimum of five drivers within each team will perform as many laps as possible for a given duration of time.

To enter the competition, each team will either pay Kshs. 15,000/= to participate or in addition place their banner at the rate of, Kshs. 2,000/=, 3,000/= and 10,000/= for small, medium and large banners, respectively.

Those who wish to be main sponsors will be given a chance to place their banner within the circuit at a cost of Kshs 20,000/=.

We request that you to team with us on this event so that we may better the lives of the less unfortunate in our community.

As you team with us in this worthy course, may the law of reciprocity take its course by bringing back to you, a bigger measure of what you will give, pressed done, shaken and overflowing!!

WHAT IS ROUND TABLE

Round Table is a movement of young men between the age of 18 and 40 from different educational, business and professional backgrounds who come together using their different ideas and resources for the betterment of the community and less fortunate members of society. Round Tables in Kenya come together under the regional body RTEA.

The First Round Table was formed in Norwich, UK in 1927. The founder, Louis Marchesi, was a young member of Norwich Rotary Club who felt a need existed for a club where young business men of the town could gather on a regular basis. At their meetings they could exchange ideas, learn from the experiences of their colleagues and play a collective part in the civic life. Within a year of inception the membership of this Round Table had grown to 85 and interest was being shown in establishing Round Tables elsewhere. Round Table now flourishes in the majority of European countries, throughout Africa, the Middle East, India, Hong Kong, New Zealand and America. In fact Round Table is represented in every continent of the world.

From a very early stage it was agreed that Round Table would be a non-religious, non-political club.

ROUND TABLE NAME AND BADGE

Round Table owes nothing to Arthurian Legend, deriving both its title and its maxim from a speech made to the British Industries Fair in 1927 by the then Prince of Wales: "The young business and professional men of this country must get together round the table, **ADOPT** methods that have proved so sound in the past, **ADAPT** them to changing needs of the times and wherever possible, **IMPROVE** them.

The phrase **ADOPT, ADAPT, IMPROVE** is a key facet of the organization and is often seen on Round Table literature and regalia.

The design of the Round Table emblem is however, an adaptation of the table which hangs in the Great Hall in Winchester. Although this is claimed to be the Round Table of the mythical court of King Arthur, it is in fact a representation which was made in the 13th century.

ROUND TABLE AIMS & OBJECTIVES

- To develop the acquaintance of young men through the medium of their business and professional occupations.
- To emphasize the fact that one's own calling offers an excellent medium of service to the community.
- To cultivate the highest ideals in business, professional and civic traditions.
- To recognize the worthiness of all legitimate occupations and to dignify each of his own by precept and example.
- To further the establishment of peace and goodwill in international relationships.
- To further these objectives by meetings, lectures, discussions and other activities.



COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

MKOWENI PRIMARY SCHOOL, BOMBOLULU

A disadvantaged school situated in Mombasa with a population of 350 (most of them orphans or too poor to pay school fees) students with very basic learning equipment. It was formed ten years ago by a government school teacher and has been surviving on well wishers since. MRT3 assists the school by providing them with 120 desks (they have no desks and are taking lessons on the floor!) in a first phase of rehabilitating this primary school.

WEEK OF HEALING

A yearly community service project looking to assist villages/ townships in the Coast Province who are in dire need of medical assistance. We get doctors to donate their services for a whole week and organize operations to the less fortunate at no cost. Our costs for the week of healing is usually approximately 7500€ which pays for all the medicines/equipment transport and accommodation for the doctors during the week of healing. Most of the medicines are donated by well wishers. The doctors time is donated free of charge. We operate on an average of 100 patients with most cases being gynecological cases, hydroceles which are common in the Coast Region.

TARU PRIMARY SCHOOL

A school situated in a village approximately 90 kilometers from Mombasa. It has a student population of 800. The school didn't have any toilet facilities until last year when MRT3 built 8 for the school. The roof is leaking, they have no windows, very few desks and most important NO WATER. Mombasa Round Table 3 is currently conducting fundraisers to collect approximately 35000€ to go towards rehabilitating the Taru Primary school.

MOMBASA ROUND TABLE 3 FUND RAISING

In order to collect funds to conduct our various community service projects MRT3 yearly holds a number of fund raising activities.

Last year we held a Pre world Release of the latest Harry Potter movie at Nyali Cinemax on the 12th July 2007. Other events listed are Golf Tournament at the Nyali Golf course, a Quiz Night at Voyager Beach Resort and a Party night at Wild Waters. This year we plan to hold a number of events. Don't miss out on those unique and charitable occasions.

FELLOWSHIP

Round Table is not just about charity and community service. Mombasa Round Table 3 is also (and maybe sometimes better) known for fellowship, fun and networking between the tablers. Monthly socials with families or among friends make Tabling in Mombasa an absolute must for young professionals.

- Date:** Saturday 25th October 2008
- Time:** Afternoon (16.00hrs onwards)
- Place:** Mombasa Go Karting near Severin Beach Hotel, Mombasa
- Event:** Corporate endurance race (team driving). Each team drives 1 go kart around the track during 1 hour, trying to get as many laps as possible. At a normal speed each team should average around 100laps. Depending on the number of team we will race for 1, 2 or 3 hours.
- Teams:** Max 8 teams per hour (max amount of running cars during endurance race) with each 5 members (ideal number).
- Kart Price:** 15.000Kshs per car
- Promotion Price:** Banner space is 2000Ksh (small banner), 5000Ksh (medium banner), 10.000Kshs (large banner) and 20.000Kshs (main Sponsor).
- Go Kart Food:** Food and drinks are run by Mombasa Go Kart. Prices are reasonable with beers from 120Kshs to 140Kshs and sodas at 60Kshs. They will have an à la carte menu available with Goat-, chicken, beef Choma, Sima, Rice, Chips, Kachumbari and more.
